# CONTEXT

During the creation of the LookUp Tables posted on the Cranwellian Historical Society (CHS) website, we have researched the content of a number of authoritative websites to identify Cranwellians who may have lost their lives in the service of their country. Post-WWII, most such casualties arose from aircraft accidents and there is much on the internet that portrays the detail of these incidents. That said, the focus tends to be on the loss of the aircraft and not necessarily of the crew. Accordingly. It has been very difficult to definitively identify all the Cranwellian losses and thereby to pay tribute to their sacrifice. Where we have, their names are listed in the relevant Roll of Honour on the CHS site.

In this album - a byproduct of our research on Cranwellian losses - we list some (by no means all) of the aircraft losses that the RAF endured since the end of WWII. For a complete list, we recommend you subscribe to the Air of Authority forum at [rafweb.org](http://rafweb.org); we have listed in this album only those freely available elsewhere. We have printed in **red** those aircraft losses known to have involved Cranwellian crew. Listing the remainder may assist those who are able to positively identify accidents that involved other Cranwellians and we would welcome feedback [[ibms520@gmail.com](mailto:ibms520@gmail.com)] to amend our records.
