Phase 2 Training graduations occur as independent events (e.g. Wings Ceremonies for GD till February 1977; Initial Engineering Courses for Engineers; Secretarial Officers Courses for Secretarial; Initial Supply Courses for Supply).

As this period from 17 GE to 40 GE evolves, alignment between 'parent' GEs and Wings/IEC/SOC/IECs becomes more difficult to follow, but there remains some alignment.
