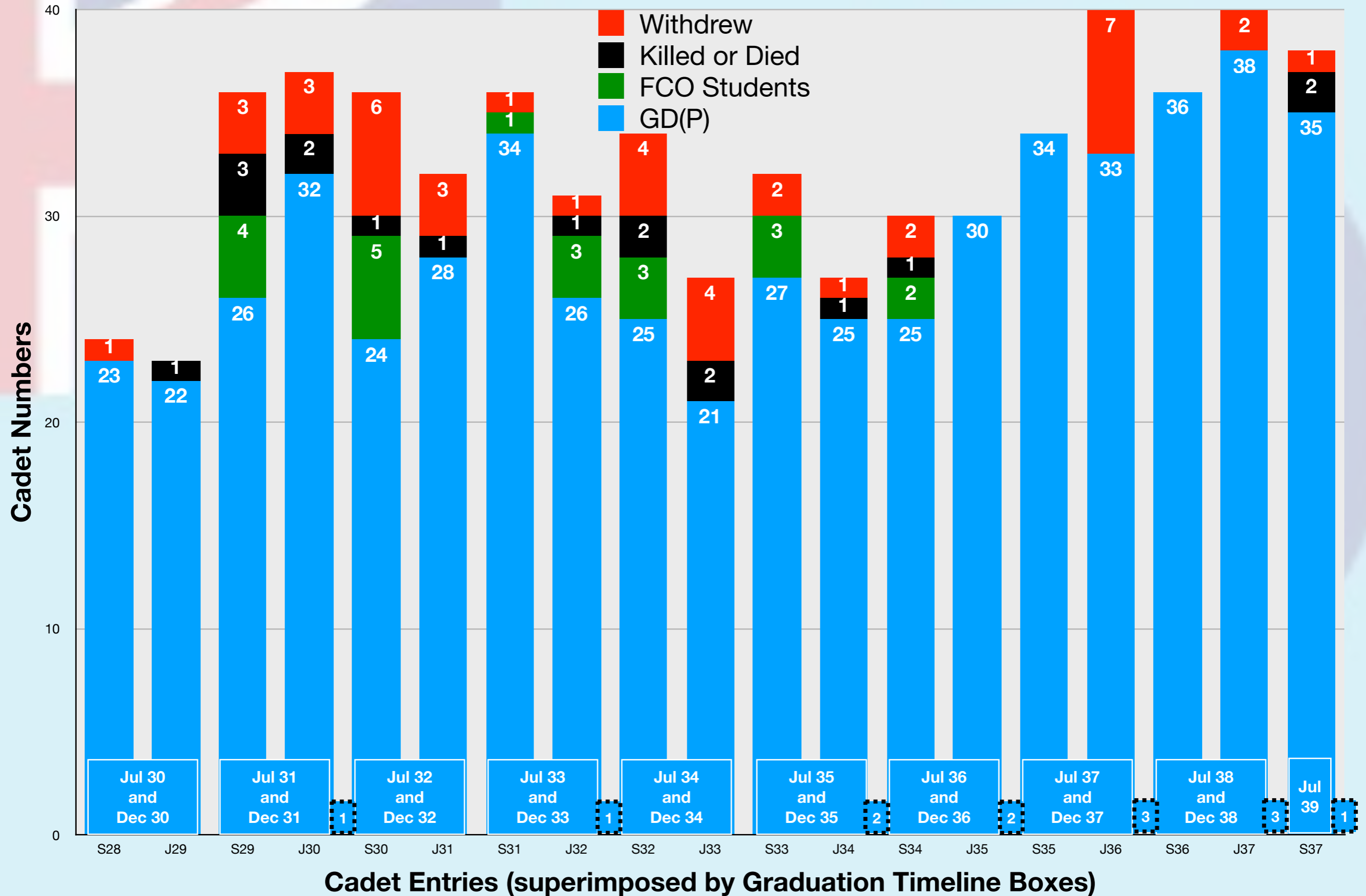

GC ACTION

On 30 Sep 40, a Blenheim bomber was taking off from RAF Wattisham when one engine cut out and the bomber crashed in flames. Sinclair immediately went to the scene to help, but two 250lb bombs exploded before he reached it. Undeterred, and knowing full well that there were two more 250lb bombs on board, he pressed on and dashed into the burning wreck.

Of the three crew he was able to drag out the air gunner, Sergeant Walters, and take him to an ambulance. Unfortunately he died from his injuries. The pilot, Sergeant J Merrett was killed.

The navigator, Sergeant Byron, survived but Sinclair did not discover this for 50 years.

VC ACTION

Having already led his Blenheim bomber squadron on two successful attacks against the heavily defended Bizerta airfield in North Africa in late Nov 42, Malcolm displayed further outstanding courage leading a thirteen-strong Blenheim attack on an enemy fighter airfield near Chougui, Tunisia, on 4 Dec. On reaching the target, however, and starting the attack, the squadron was intercepted by an overwhelming force of enemy fighters from I and II Gruppen JG 53, and 11 Staffel, JG 2. One by one all his bombers were shot down, until Malcolm himself was shot down in flames.

GC ACTION

On 11 Feb 40, the SS Kildare was hit by two bombs. One exploded in the grain cargo, which shifted, causing the ship to list heavily; the other lodged in the after deck cabin, but did not explode. The ship limped into Immingham Dock. Dowland-Ryan, with Armament Instructor Leonard Harrison GC, fitted a voltmeter to drain the electric charge. The locking rings were removed and the defused bomb was lowered into a truck for further examination.

In Jun 40, Dowland-Ryan performed a similar feat of bravery with the same efficiency and promptitude on board a trawler.

He was killed in action near Malta in 1942.

Douglas Robert Steuart Bader



D.S.O. 1 October 1940. This officer has displayed gallantry and leadership of the highest order. During three recent engagements he has led his squadron with such skill and ability that thirty-three enemy aircraft have been destroyed.

Mention 1 January 1941. In the course of these engagements Squadron Leader BADER has added to his previous successes by destroying six enemy aircraft.

D.F.C. 7 January 1941. Squadron Leader BADER has continued to lead his squadron and wing with the utmost gallantry on all occasions. He has now destroyed a total of ten hostile aircraft and damaged several more.

Mention 17 March 1941. This fourteen pilot has recently added a further four enemy aircraft to his previous successes; in addition he has probably destroyed another four and damaged five hostile aircraft. By his fine leadership and high courage Wing Commander BADER has inspired the wing on every occasion.

(21 February 1910 – 5 September 1982)

Joined the RAF in 1928, commissioned in 1930, lost both legs in an aerobatic accident in 1931. Despite being discharged on medical grounds, he rejoined in 1939 to become a renowned flying ace, credited with 22 aerial victories, four shared victories, six probables, one shared probable and 11 enemy aircraft damaged. Shot down in 1941 - blue-on-blue - he 'resided' in Colditz Camp for the next 4 years.

 In June 1941, this officer was captain of the leading aircraft of a formation of three aircraft which carried out an attack on KIEL in clear daylight. Despite accurate anti-aircraft fire, bombs were dropped and destroyed in burst on the objective. The success which attended this operation was largely due to the magnificent leadership and courage together with the brilliant armanship displayed by this officer.

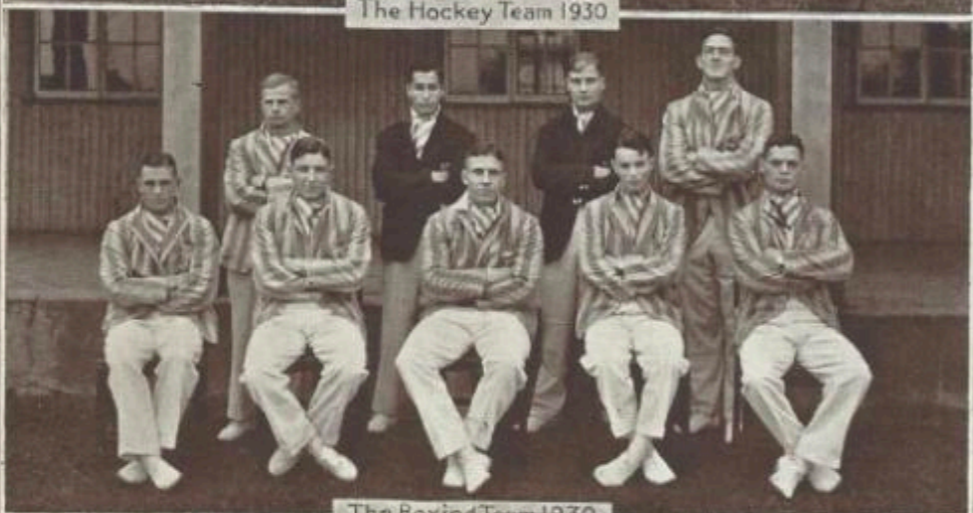

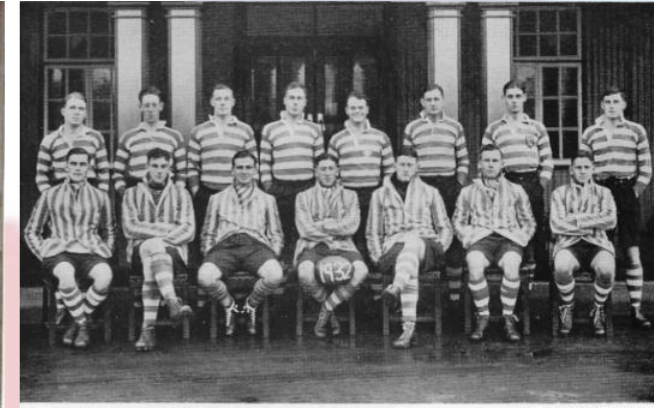

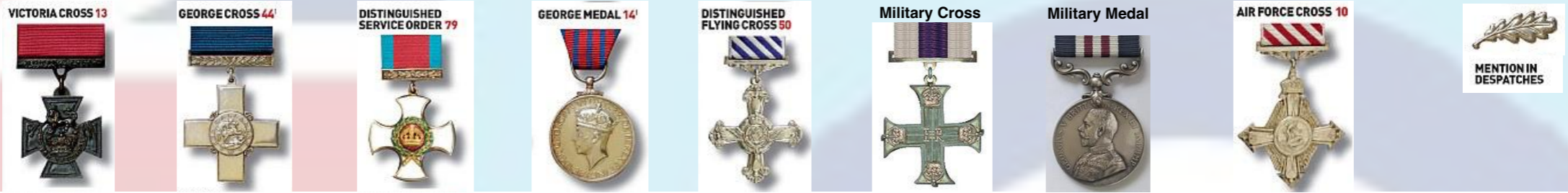
