### **First Revision**

"On a miserable November morning {1 November 2019}, a Cranwellian and his two Standard Poodle dogs set out from the Brunei Centre opposite the RAF Cranwell guardroom to visit the Cranwell Village Church, St Andrew's."

So began Version 1.0 of this tribute album intended to commemorate the 200 Cranwellians buried at St Andrew's Church. In truth, despite devoted local volunteer effort notably from Wg Cdr (Ret'd) Trevor Bush, the graveyard looked a little tired that day, betraying its age in inclement weather. The attempts of the author to capture the scene, somewhat distracted by his two large poodles straining on their leash, were ill planned and, at best, opportunistic. His well intentioned task did at least record the presence of most Cranwellians buried at St Andrew's, but here too there were mistakes and omissions. This Version 2.0 is an attempt to rectify those mistakes, benefitting from the feedback provided by the Cranwellian Association (CA) and, in particular, two members - Peter Symes (76 Entry) and Duncan Heard (50 Entry).

Fast forward to 2021. Through the CA, we learnt the splendid news that the CWGC had agreed to assume responsibility for the upkeep of Cranwellian graves at St Andrew's. Consequently, the graves now benefit from the care and attention



for which the CWGC is renowned. We commend to your reading their outstanding work, which may be accessed through the following link:

#### THE CHURCHYARD AND THE WAR GRAVES



Burials have been carried out in the churchyard surrounding the ancient parish church of Saint Andrew, Cranwell for at least a thousand years. Until the twentieth century the capacity of the churchyard met without difficulty the historic needs of the parish, but in the Twentieth Century the advent of a military unit in the parish precipitated a population explosion. In 1915 the Admiralty selected six sites in the East of England, of which Cranwell was one, to become airship bases. The initial Admiralty base at Cranwell, HMS Daedalus, became in turn a Royal Flying Corps Station, an RAF

station and eventually the Royal Air Force College as we know it today.

The Royal Air Force College is one of the RAF's largest units and occupies two thirds of the parish. It actually straddles three parishes but the bulk of the College is in Cranwell. Although the RAF College has three churches: St Michael's, St Peter's and St Andrew's (not to be confused with the Cranwell Parish Church of St Andrew's) none of these churches has a burial ground and deaths at the College usually result in a burial in the parish churchyard. Learning to fly has always been hazardous and it is possible to trace from the military graves the development of aviation from airships to the aircraft of today. There are about 200 military graves in the churchyard.

The PCC is not under any obligation to reserve a section of the churchyard for military graves, but it chooses to do in support of the Royal Air Force College and the many service families living locally. The eastern-most section of the churchyard contains only military graves, whilst the Northwest quadrant (containing the oldest military graves) and a section of the churchyard to the east of the chancel contain a mixture of military and civilian graves.

#### VISITING INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE, we have been advised (in August 2020) that the north wall of the churchyard is in danger of collapse. As a result, the CWGC has decided to remove the 18 headstones in the vicinity of the wall (mostly in Plot 3) into safe storage, until further notice. Please contact the CWGC Enquiries Section for further details.

#### HISTORY INFORMATION

Cranwell has been a flying training centre since the First World War when the Admiralty requisitioned 2500 acres of the Earl of Bristol's estate in November 1915, to create the Royal Naval Air Service Central Training Depot. Since then the aerodrome has been taken over by the Royal Air Force and the RAF Staff College is at Cranwell.

The graves of 25 First World War airmen will be found on the northern side of the church. The churchyard was used between the wars for RAF burials and during the Second World War the RAF plot, in the eastern part of the churchyard, was used for service burials not only from Cranwell RAF station but from others also, including Finningley and Binbrook.

Cranwell (St Andrew) Churchyard contains 25 Commonwealth burials of the First World War and 58 from the Second. There are also four Polish war graves.

# Service to celebrate renovation of war graves in village

A service is to be held to rededicate the war graves in Cranwell churchyard on Tuesday (November 30)The event will mark the refurbishment of the Commonwealth War Graves at Cranwell parish church on St Andrew's Day from 10.30am.

Priest in Charge, Rev Al Jenkins explained that in 2016, the Armed Force Covenant Fund Trust provided the Commonwealth War Graves Commission with a grant to renovate war graves across the United Kingdom. Phase one focussed on more than 6,000 scattered graves, some of which were in small plots located in numerous churchyards, and was completed in late 2018.

Phase two commenced in 2019 to renovate a large churchyard plot at St Andrew's Church, Cranwell, as well as 11 war cemeteries. Hampered by the Covid pandemic, work got under way in the spring of this year.

The project was led by the CWGC's regional manager Chris Hawes and the work carried out by the church's own team with support from contractors. The project also benefitted from the support and guidance of church warden, retired Wing Commander Trevor Bush.

The rededication will be led by The Rt Rev Dr Nigel Peyton, assisted by Rev Jenkins.

Saint Andrew Churchyard is located east of Cranwell on Sleaford Road, in Lincolnshire.

There has been a church on the land since Saxon times. The Saxon church was torn down and rebuilt by the Normans. It was restored in 1904.

The churchyard serves the local RAF base. It is still used for burials at this time and is well maintained by Cranwell parish council.


